What you need to do:

1. **Group investigation:**

a. You are to select an area in the school, create a list of the materials in that area. Remember you will need this list for your research.

2. Collecting Investigation Notes:

- a. During your group investigation you are required to complete the Your Investigation sheet. Remember you will submit this sheet to your teacher, and it is graded and contributes to your overall mark.
- b. You must use a variety of sources to gain information, and place them on a separate page in alphabetical order

3. Individual Statement: 200-300 words

a. You are to write a brief individual statement answering the question: "Why do you think protecting the environment is important?"

4. Group presentation: 2-3 minutes

- a. Your presentation to the principal is to be persuasive and explain the following
 - i. What materials are currently being used within your chosen area
 - ii. Why should these materials be changed and what effects are they having on the environment
 - iii. What materials should they be changed for
 - iv. Why is it important to protect the environment

5. Presenting to the Principal:
